Effective Methods for UI Stakeholder Collaboration

- States vary in the methods used to evaluate and develop unemployment insurance law, policy and administration.
- State UI Advisory Councils vary in authority. Models include
 - Research only councils with academic focus.
 - Policy councils that advise the state UI agency about customer impact and best practices.
 - Legislative advisory councils that review proposed legislation for federal compliance, fiscal impact, and impact on stakeholders.
 - Combinations of research, legislative and policy collaboration.
- Councils also vary in composition with legislative leaders, gubernatorial appointments, business, labor and public representatives.
- Legislative committee collaboration with dedicated policy staff.
