## What is STC?

- Also known as work sharing or shared-work
- Allows employers to reduce hours of work for employees versus laying them off
  - Business can retain a talented workforce during economic downturns—rather than laying off the workforce and having to recruit, hire, and train new staff when the economy recovers – STC employers can reduce overhead by temporarily cutting hours.
- Employees collect a percentage of their UI benefits to replace the lost wages
  - They keep their jobs at a reduced schedule, keep their benefits, and are able to file for partial unemployment benefits for the lost wages.
- Employees must be monetarily eligible for UI
- The amount of UI paid to individuals filing for STC is pro-rated based on what they would receive if they were unemployed
- Cannot be operational if it doesn't conform with the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA)



## **Benefits of STC**

## **During Business Contraction**

### **Supports employee retention:**

- Employees can stay on the job and maintain their skills
- Workers avoid total unemployment
- Morale is increased
- Health benefits are retained

#### Saves employers money:

- Retraining costs avoided
- UI Taxes may be lower
- Rehiring costs are avoided
- Recovery is faster

## **Other Benefits**

- Reduces the burden on the UI system, if less people are unemployed
- Stabilizes local economies during economic downturns by avoiding loss of consumer spending and reducing unemployment
